Our internationally recognized Company is built on a rich 53-year history, and boasts a repertoire that is creative, artistically expressive and collaborative.

Each component of Texas Ballet Theater's Community Enrichment Program is designed to fill the void for children and youth who would otherwise lack access to the arts. CityDance's qualified ballet instructors offer a free five-week series of introductory ballet classes.

CityDance reaches over 1,000 students annually and is a recognized partner of the Fort Worth and Dallas Independent School Districts. Through exposure to the fundamentals of ballet, CityDance students learn movement, French terminology and classical music education.

SUMMARY

Texas Ballet Theater (TBT) employs Community Enrichment ballet instructors — to be enthusiastic ambassadors for the art form and professional representatives of TBT. Our CityDance Instructors introduce ballet to young students across the Dallas Fort Worth Metroplex, primarily 1st – 5th grades.

The goals of TBT's Community Enrichment department are to enrich the lives of children by providing dance education, building awareness of the art form and growing a new generation of art enthusiasts. CityDance is the primary branch of TBT's outreach into the local community. The CityDance program occurs throughout the year at public schools, community centers and children's organizations.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES include the following. Other duties may be assigned.

- Follow core curriculum to teach beginning ballet for up to 40 students for 1-hour class sessions.
- Collaborate with school teachers while on school campus to ensure program runs in an efficient, organized manner.

- Provide positive and healthy support for students, as a leader and a mentor.
- Maintain a positive, disciplined environment for the students during their ballet class.

BFA in Dance or BA Dance Education, or commensurate experience as a professional dancer. Demonstrated experience working in dance education with grades 1-5.

- Excellent communication, organizational and team-working skills.
- Flexible schedule- late afternoons into the evening hours.
- Willingness to commute to various parts of the Dallas Fort Worth Metroplex.
- Demonstrated capability and maturity to protect confidential information and build trust and rapport with program participants and community partners with TBT.
- Adapt to change and respond to unexpected occurrences.

LANGUAGE SKILLS

Ability to read, analyze and interpret instructions and correspondence. Ability to write professional correspondence; effectively present one-on-one or to small and large groups of students and other staff members of the organization and community.

MATHEMATICAL SKILLS

Ability to calculate figures and amounts such as discounts, proportions and percentages and ability to apply concepts of basic math.

COMPUTER SKILLS
